### **Scripture Focus**

## **Making Room for Discipline**

Growing up, I HATED discipline. My dad used to say the only form of discipline he ever had to use on me was just give me a look & I would start bawling. I believed this lie that if someone disciplined me then I had failed them. I used to get so offended when someone would try to correct me. There was this lie in my head that discipline = disappointment. But as I became a parent, God has slowly showed me that discipline = love. If He did not care about me, He wouldn't correct me. If I am receiving correction, whether from the Holy Spirit, or those around me, I have come to realize it is because God wants to reveal something greater within me. He wants to shape my character to look more like Jesus, so when I stand before Him, I can say that I welcomed His discipline & did not wish it away.

#### Does discipline equal disappointment or love to you?

Take a few moments to reflect. Do you think of disappointment when you hear the word discipline, or do you think love? I would challenge you to put yourself around people who will keep you accountable & call out the areas that you may need to grow in, in love.

Ask yourself these few questions:

- Do I invite discipline into my life, or do I run from it?
- Do I have people in my life who can keep me accountable to my shortcomings?
- Have I invited the Holy Spirit into my heart to love me through correction?

God has called you a SON & a DAUGHTER. This is good news, & let's see how his discipline transforms us in our character & relationships.
